The Town Council had only been able to carry out limited work due to lockdown however now our Warden has returned to work much of the area is beginning to look so much better.

The devolution of Old Roselyon, Penarwyn and Deeble Drive play areas is progressing with it now in the hands of solicitors. The areas will belong to the Town Council and will be responsible for their maintenance.

The new extension at The Burrows Centre will be open as soon as lockdown is lifted.

I have received notification that the Tour of Britain will be postponed for a year. This is a disappointment.

The Town Council is proposing to purchase a speed detector for Station Road with the hope this will reduce speeding traffic.

Work on the Britannia Roundabout is yet to begin, just another project affected by the lock down but I am sure it will be worth the wait.

The St Austell Bay Resilient Regeneration Project has submitted plans for the top of Trenovissik Road, Doubletrees and Bull Engine Park and these have now been approved. This is the start of the flood alleviation plans, which will see a great reduction in the possibility of St. Blazey flooding again.

I hope by that in the not too distant future we will back to normal but in the meantime please ensure that you maintain social distancing, take care and stay safe.
