#### 1302/06 **COMMUNITY WARDENS REPORT**

#### 1302/07 **A REPORT FROM CORNWALL COUNCILLOR ROY TAYLOR**

Councillor Taylor apologised for not attending the Community Watch meeting, he did not return from his travels early enough to attend.

Councillor Taylor attended the Feast parade and service on 3<sup>rd</sup> February and said what a good event it had been.

Councillor Taylor and Councillor Heyward have measured the road width in Prideaux Road/New Road and he believes it is wide enough to install a pavement. Councillor Taylor will add this to his list of highway Improvements.

Councillor Taylor told the Council that the planning application for the site of the closed public house, the Cornish Arms has been withdraw.

Councillor Taylor had attended Child Sex Exploitation Awareness Training and realised that this type of abuse is more common than realised. He urged anybody with the opportunity to attend a similar event.

New signs are to be put up warning of the Schools at Biscovey.

Councillor Taylor had attended the Council meeting on February 26<sup>th</sup> when the Cornwall Councillors voted for a freeze in Cornwall's rate of Council Tax.

Councillor Taylor is investigating as to whether an area as large as St Blaise is the only one without any recycling bins.

#### 1302/08 **A REPORT FROM CORNWALL COUNCILLOR DAVID HUGHES**

Councillor Hughes had attended the Cornwall Council meeting deciding the Council Tax rate and had voted for a 2% rise as he feels that the increase will have to be inflated greatly in future years when this could have been avoided.

Councillor Hughes reported that Cornwall Council and Imerys will be working together to repair a collapsed pipe, which is causing flooding in the area of Skew Bridge. There will be a road closure in due course.

SWW have previously insinuated that there may be compensation for the residents of Brooks Corner who have suffered sewage being returned through their water systems for a number of years. They have now saying that there will not be any compensation and so those affected are putting a legal case together and are looking for support from the national media.

Councillor Hughes has concerns regarding the planning application that has been submitted for the land at Millers Nook as there is a disused mine under the land. He also has concerns about an application at the Mount and hopes that a compromise can be found.

#### 1302/09 **COMMUNITY RESILIENCE**

Cornwall Councillor Taylor, Councillor Allen and Councillor Anderson had all attended a community resilience day at The Eden Project. The event gave guidance on procedures in case of a serious incident and emergencies. Cornwall Council will provide equipment to dedicated volunteer groups to use in case of severe weather. All this information can be found on the Community Resilience Web-site.

#### 1302/10 **COMMUNITY RIGHT TO BID**

The Clerk has spoken with a DGLG Localism Officer who feels that we should give greater consideration to any of our proposals before requesting that they are added to the register.

#### 1302/11 **REQUESTS FOR DONATIONS**

**Donation to Cornwall Air Ambulance.** Cornwall Air Ambulance has requested a donation to assist them in keeping the helicopter flying. Councillor Miller proposed a donation of £300, Councillor Hooper seconded the proposal, all the Council agreed and so it was RESOLVED. Local Government and Rating Act 1997 s26-29.

**Shelter Cornwall.** Shelter Cornwall has requested a donation towards their running costs. Councillor Seel proposed a donation of £300, Councillor Putt seconded the proposal, all the Council agreed and so it was RESOLVED. LGA 1972 s139.

**Arthritis Research.** Arthritis Research has requested a donation towards their research being carried out in a hospital in Truro. Councillor Hooper proposed a donation of £100, Councillor Allen seconded the proposal, 1 Councillor voted against, 1 Councillor abstained but due to the majority it was RESOLVED. LGA 1972 s139.

**Par Bay Skatepark.** Par Bay Skatepark are seeking funds from local organisations to further their project. They are requesting that we seek pre-application advice on their behalf. Councillor Putt proposed that we apply for them, Councillor Seel seconded the proposal, all the Council agreed and so it was RESOLVED. Local Government(Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 s19.

### 1302/12 **RECRUITMENT OF TOWN COUNCILLORS**

Councillor June Anderson asked the Councillors to try to recruit new Councillors in preparation for the elections in May 2013.

### 1302/13 **IMPLECATIONS OF LOCALISM AND CORNWALL COUNCIL CUTS**

The Clerk attended a meeting of the Larger Councils CALC meeting and was informed that the Localism Team no longer existed. This is due to the cut from the budget which was set on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2013. The clerk will speak with our Community Network Manager to see how this will affect us.

### 1302/14 **PROJECT LIST**

**New Community Centre** – The next part of our application for lottery funding to extend the Burrows must be received by 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2013.

**Neighbourhood Planning** – The Clerk told the Council that the contracts have not yet been returned from Hartnell Taylor Cook for the lease of unit 2 by Co-op. Groups have divided to write an Engagement Policy and Evidence Gathering Strategy. The next meeting is expected to be 18<sup>th</sup> March. The Clerk has received a letter from a resident who would like to see an all-purpose Retirement Home in the Town; this will be passed onto NP Steering Group.

### 1302/15 **TOWN CLERKS REPORT**

The Clerk attended the SLCC Regional Conference when we were strongly advised to write a Compassionate Leave Policy. The Clerk will arrange a meeting with Councillors Allen and Miller.

The Clerk told the Council that Par Old Cornwall Society had contacted her regarding the bricks that were the entrance to the Treffry Estate. Cornwall Councillor Roy Taylor will chase up the relevant department regarding the Bell Tower currently housed in Fourways Car Park so that arrangements can be made to move both objects to the entrance to the Town Car Park.
