Report by the Mayor of St Blaise Town Council. Councillor June Anderson.

Since returning from lockdown Warden Dave Pearce has again been furloughed and so unfortunately we have had to close Trail Blazer Park for safety. Due to the recent rain the ground is so wet and so the Council agreed this was the best way forward. The park will be re-open from Monday 7th December

The devolution of Old Roselyon, Penarwyn and Deeble Drive play areas is progressing but this was delayed as we had to negotiate the definition of the land at Polgover.as a three piece of land transfer this has delayed the other two areas.

We were pleased that we were able to get Alexander Hall, the Community Rooms and June Anderson Hall back functioning but had to close them again due to the 2nd lockdown however they re-opened on December 2nd.

I laid the Town Council wreath at the memorial at St Blazey Church on Sunday 8th November but it was a great shame that the usual service was unable to take place.

I am very pleased to report that this year's St Blazey Community Award is being given to the Gaulton Family who set up Rainbow your Street and for their work in the Community.

Your Street was founded by 10yr old Harley. Harley is Autistic and was looking for a way back into his community after feeling alone and isolated from the world around him. Harley has been doing many acts of kindness in his street by handing out free colouring packs, giving every household a free rainbow heart to hang in their window, providing free home school time capsule learning packs, providing and hiding painted rocks, for the children and families to hunt and find during their walks, organised a Easter egg design competition, set up a memorial tree for people to mark the loss of loved ones, by tying a ribbon and many more kindnesses to brighten up his street, his community and the lives of many individuals in times of need.

Harley broadened his efforts to help and support his community by providing funds to where it's most needed by opening a crowdfunding site. He raised funds to brighten up his local street and children's park, supported local events for children and families during holiday times and general up keep to ensure safety.

The family Jo, Keith and Harley set up a just giving page and have raised enough money to buy a seat for Penarwyn Green for all too enjoy. We are sure that all will agree that they are worthy recipients.

The last few months have been extremely difficult for me personally as I know it has for many of you I hope by the next issue of the PL24 Magazine life will be better for us all. I leave with the message take care and stay safe.
